Licht – Stockhausen's Legacy

Brilliant. Megalomaniacal. Unstaggable.

These are just some of the words used to describe *Licht* (Light), the monumental and radical opera cycle composed by Karlheinz Stockhausen between 1977 and 2003.

Never performed in its entirety — musically and theatrically too complex, logically overwhelming, and financially exorbitant — *Licht* seemed destined to remain a myth.

And yet, in 2016, under the direction of world-renowned stage director Pierre Audi (1957–2025), the Dutch National Opera, the Holland Festival, the Royal Conservatoire of The Hague, and the Stockhausen Foundation took on the impossible challenge: bringing this extraordinary work to the stage.

After three years of tireless work, more than 400 rehearsals with 500 musicians and dancers, 4 helicopters, over 1,000 costumes and props, and an unshakable determination, *Licht* finally came to life.

The documentary retraces this exceptional journey, following Pierre Audi as he brings this titanic production to the stage, while also delving into the avant-garde and mystical musical universe of Karlheinz Stockhausen (1928–2007), one of the most controversial composers of the 20th century.
